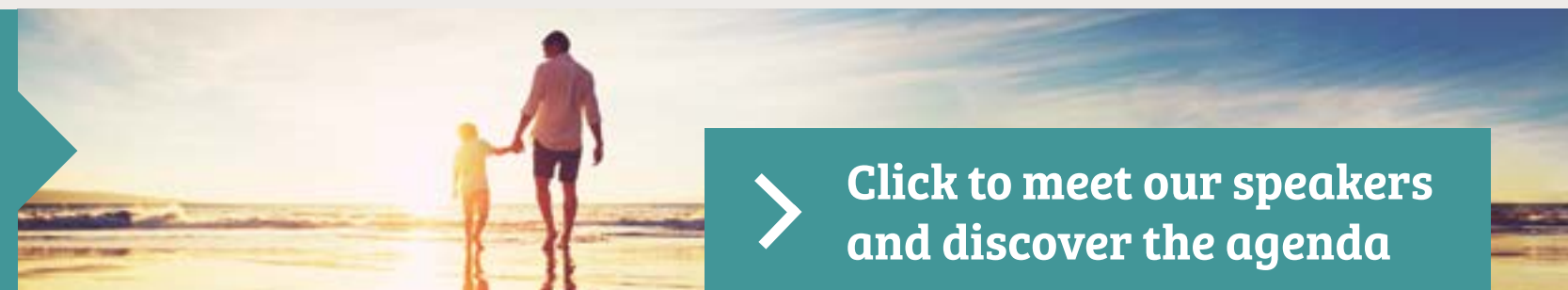

Dr Gudrun Schleiermacher – Paediatric Oncologist and Biologist – France

Current physician-scientist at the Institut Curie and Principle Investigator on the European opsoclonus-myoclonus trial and SIOOPEN LINES trial. Dr Schleiermacher completed training in Paediatrics in France and the UK, and completed training as a Paediatric Oncologist at the Institut Curie (France). Dr Schleiermacher also holds a PhD in Genetics and Biology of Cancer and has authored many notable publications. An active member of the European Neuroblastoma Community, Dr Schleiermacher holds leadership positions on the Neuroblastoma Committee of SECE, SIOOPEN Biology Group, and Advances in Neuroblastoma Research (ANR).



Professor Deborah Tweddle – Paediatric Oncologist – UK

Current Professor of Paediatric Oncology at Newcastle University and Honorary Consultant in Paediatric & Adolescent Oncology at the Great North Children's Hospital, Newcastle (UK). Professor Tweddle is an active member of the Neuroblastoma community across the UK and Europe. Professor Tweddle holds multiple leadership positions within the community including with the Neuroblastoma sub-group and the national neuroblastoma molecular diagnostics reference service based at the Newcastle Genetics Laboratory. Professor Tweddle's research group, established in 2002, has published over 75 peer-reviewed papers and book chapters.



Dr Stefano Avanzini – Consultant Paediatric Surgeon – Italy

Current consultant paediatric surgeon at Gaslini Children's Hospital. Dr Avanzini is focused on paediatric oncological surgery, minimally invasive surgery, gastro-intestinal surgery, and central venous catheterisation. Since graduating in Paediatric Surgery at Gaslini Children's Hospital in 2008, Dr Avanzini has held surgical positions in children's hospitals in Ireland and across a number of locations in Italy.
